

Baker Beach and Bluffs to Golden Gate Bridge

Preferred Alternative:

Dog walking would be allowed onleash south of the north end of the north parking lot, as well as the trails to the beach south of the north end of the north parking lot and the multi-use Coastal Trail. Permits would be issued to commercial/individual dog walkers for walking more than three dogs.

Alternative A: No Action
(36 CFR 2.15, 36 CFR 7.97 (d);
1979 Pet Policy; GGNRA Compendium)

Dog walking would continue to be allowed under voice control north of Lobos Creek, and on-leash on all trails except the Batteries to Bluffs Trail.

Alternative B: NPS Leash Regulation (36 CFR 2.15 and GGNRA Compendium)

Dog walking would be allowed on-leash on the beach and all trails except the Batteries to Bluffs and Battery Crosby Trails.

Alternative C: Emphasis on Multiple Use Balanced by County

Same as Alternative B.

Alternative D: Most Protective Based on Resource Protection and Visitor Safety
Dog walking would be allowed on-leash on the beach south of the north end of the north parking lot, as well as the trails to the beach south of the north end of the north

parking lot and the multi-use Coastal Trail.

Alternative E: Most Dog Walking Access and Management Intensive

Dog walking would be allowed on-leash on the beach north of the north end of the north parking lot and all trails except the Batteries to Bluffs and Battery Crosby Trails. Dog walking would also be allowed under ROLA regulations on the beach south of the north end of the north parking lot.
