A number of comments requested additions of resources or corrections to the maps portrayed in the study. Since the study was intended to determine if the Route met criteria for congressional designation as a National Historic Trail, the study team will pass such comments along to the planning team that will conduct the comprehensive trail plan should the trail be designated by Congress. The suggested additions or map corrections would not have affected the determination that the trail is consistent with applicable designation criteria.
