On September 13, 2011, Golden Gate National Recreation Area announced the opening of a 60 day public review and comment period for the Draft General Management Plan/ Environmental Impact Statement (GMP/EIS). The public comment period ends November 7, 2011, not November 14 as previously stated. Also, there is an omission in the Summary Edition of the Draft GMP/EIS relating to the number of additional employees called for in the Preferred Alternative. Table 2 on page 58 shows the number of additional employees to be 380 full-time equivalent (FTE) staff. The correct number is 46 additional employees bringing the total staffing number to 380FTE. The correct table is found in Volume I on page xxvi, and is fully described on pages 223 - 225.

This plan is intended to guide management of GGNRA, including Muir Woods and Alcatraz Island, over the next 20 years. The public is an important part of this planning effort and is asked to comment on the Draft at this time.

## COMMENT PERIOD

The 60-day public review period will run through November 7. The full document comes in 3 volumes, but there is a short Executive Summary in Volume I, and a separate Summary Edition which focuses on the preferred alternative. All of the documents are posted online at www.parkplanning.nps.gov/GGNRA\_GMP. Reference copies of the plan are available at libraries in San Mateo, San Francisco, and Marin Counties.
