### General Management Plan Draft Now Available for Review

**Golden Gate National Recreation Area, Calif.** The Draft General Management Plan/ Environmental Impact Statement (GMP/EIS) for Golden Gate National Recreation Area (GGNRA) is now available for public review and comment. This plan is intended to guide management of GGNRA, including Muir Woods and Alcatraz Island, over the next 20 years. The public is an important part of this planning effort and is asked to comment on the Draft at this time.

#### COMMENT PERIOD

The 60-day public review period will run through November 14. The full document comes in 3 volumes, but there is a short Executive Summary in Volume 1, and a separate Summary Edition which focuses on the preferred alternative. This week the Summary Edition was mailed to about 3,500 people and the documents were posted online at [www.parkplanning.nps.gov/GGNRA\\_GMP](http://www.parkplanning.nps.gov/GGNRA_GMP). Reference copies of the plan are available at libraries in San Mateo, San Francisco, and Marin Counties.
