Change all instances of “Pinnacles Wilderness” to “Hain Wilderness” except in historical references.

Page xi, Column 2, paragraph 2, lines 7-8: Add missing letter “e” in “foreseeable”

Page 7, Column 1, paragraph 3, Purpose of the Plan, line 3: Add missing letter “e” in “foreseeable”

Page 54, Column 1 (Facilities), Row 3: Add missing letter “l” in “Facilities”

Page 63, Column 2, Paragraph 4, McCabe Canyon, Line 7: Delete “could” and replace with “would”

p. 82, Column 1, Paragraph 3, Commercial Services, Line 2: Add “and other commercial activities” after “commercial interpretive tours”

p. 82, Column 1, Paragraph 1, Cultural Resources, Line 11: Add: “Pinnacles will seek to increase the involvement of traditionally associated peoples in research and protection of resources with traditional cultural meaning and value. Pinnacles will document and interpret the influences of traditionally associated peoples on the landscape with active engagement of these traditionally associated peoples.”

Page 84, Column 2, Paragraph 3, McCabe Canyon, Line 4: Delete “could” and replace with “would”

Page 96, Column 2, Paragraph 3, McCabe Canyon, Line 8: Delete “could” and replace with “would”

Page 119, Column 1, Row 4, Paragraph 2, lines 4-5: Delete “would continue”

Page 177, Table 22: Special Status Wildlife Species at Pinnacles National Monument, “Birds,” California condor scientific name: Replace “*californicus*” with “*californianus*”

Page 143, Column 2, Paragraph 1, Climbing, Lines 7-9: Delete “system used by the National Association of Search and Rescue” and replace with “Yosemite Decimal System”

Page 143, Column 2, Paragraph 3, Climbing, Lines 12-13: Delete “Use of brown of grey webbing” and replace with “Use of low visibility materials”

page 212, Column 2, Paragraph 2, Dark Night Skies (Lightscapes): Add, as last bullet, “Work with towns and cities within area of light pollution influence for ordinances to protect night skies from light pollution”

page 213, Column 1, Paragraph 1, Hydrologic Systems, Water Quality, and Wetlands: Add, to last bullet, “Obtain appropriate permits with the California Water Board and Army Corps of Engineers.”

page 213, Column 1, Paragraph 2, Soils: Add, to last bullet, “Establish and follow Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan as appropriate for construction projects.”
