
NEPA & Section 106 Process



DEFINE PURPOSE & NEED – FOR THE PROPOSED ACTION, NATIONAL PARK SERVICE AND U.S. SECRET SERVICE DEFINE THE PROJECT AREA, AND DEFINE THE FRAMEWORK WITHIN WHICH REASONABLE ALTERNATIVES CAN BE DEVELOPED

DATA COLLECTION - BEGIN RESOURCE INVENTORY AND ANALYSIS, DETERMINE RESOURCE TOPICS AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSED ACTION, AND INITIATE DATA COLLECTION/ RESEARCH NEEDED TO CARRY IMPACT ANALYSIS FORWARD

INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL SCOPING - HOLD PUBLIC SCOPING MEETINGS TO INTRODUCE PROJECT AND IDENTIFY ISSUES

NATIONAL CAPITAL PLANNING COMMISSION (NCPC) HELD A DESIGN COMPETITION FOR THE PROJECT AREA, THE RESULTS OF WHICH INFORMED THE DEVELOPMENT OF ALTERNATIVES FOR THE PROJECT.

DESCRIBE AFFECTED ENVIRONMENT, DEVELOP ALTERNATIVES, AND PREPARE IMPACT ANALYSIS OF ALTERNATIVES

PREPARE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

RELEASE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (EA) FOR 30-DAY PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

NATIONAL PARK SERVICE AND U.S. SECRET SERVICE TO REVIEW AND ADDRESS PUBLIC COMMENTS RECEIVED ON THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND RESPOND TO COMMENTS

PREPARE AND FINALIZE FONSI, IF APPROPRIATE AND DRAFT SECTION 106 AGREEMENT DOCUMENT.
