



# Conceptual Remediation Strategies

## Source Control Treatment

- Source control is one mitigation method that prevents or controls the formation of contaminated mine drainage by preventing air, water, or metallic materials from coming into contact with each other.
- Source control includes the use of drains to isolate water from the acid generating materials. Mine seals are another source control used to prevent the contact between air, water and acid producing materials.

Source control may require the construction of access roads to the mine sites, and the construction of trenches and drains.

Source control would require routine monitoring and maintenance.
