

# Conceptual Remediation Strategies

## Active Treatment Systems

- Active treatment is a mitigation and treatment system that involves the chemical treatment of contaminated mine drainage.
- Active treatment involves the direct placement of chemical agents in the contaminated mine drainage to neutralize the contaminated water.

Active treatment may require the construction of access roads to each contaminated mine site.

An active treatment system can be labor and maintenance intensive.



- Chemical treatment usually involves mechanical feeders, mixers, and settling basins.
