WHEREAS, in May 1999, the National Park Service (NPS), California State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), and Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) executed the *Programmatic Agreement among the National Park Service at Yosemite, the California State Historic Preservation Officer, and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation Regarding Planning, Design, Construction, Operations and Maintenance, Yosemite National Park, California* (1999 PA); and

**WHEREAS**, the NPS, SHPO, and Council (signatories to the 1999 PA) amended the 1999 PA on May 13, 2014, while consulting on the development of a new parkwide PA to address parkwide activities; and

**WHEREAS,** the NPS, SHPO, and Council agree that the 1999 PA (as amended) should be amended to extend the duration of the PA and maintain the current consultation processes as established while consulting on the development of a new parkwide PA; and

**WHEREAS,** all the consulting parties to the 1999 PA, including the traditionally associated American Indian tribes and groups and National Trust for Historic Preservation, have been provided the opportunity to review and comment on this amendment; and

WHEREAS, the general public has been provided the opportunity to review and comment on the amendment; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in accordance with *Stipulation XVI. AMENDMENTS* of the 1999 PA, the NPS, SHPO, and Council agree to amend the 1999 PA as follows:

1. Amend Stipulation XX.EXPIRATION so it reads as follows:

This agreement will remain in effect until May 14, 2017, or until a new parkwide agreement is negotiated, whichever time period is shorter.

This amendment to the 1999 PA shall become effective on the date it is executed by all three signatories.
