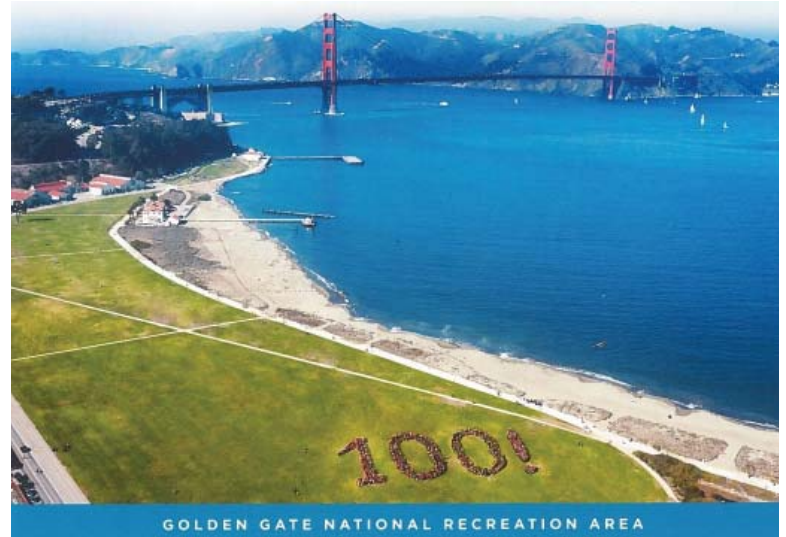


# Crissy Field Centennial Repair Project

The National Park Service has released the Crissy Field Centennial Repair Project for public comment through April 22, 2016. This project supports much-needed repairs at Crissy Field along the 1.5 mile Promenade and East Beach Parking Lot including drainage improvements, trail resurfacing, and parking lot reconfiguration.



Funding for this project is made possible by a \$2.5 million grant from the National Park Service Centennial Challenge program, which is being matched by donations from the Evelyn and Walter Haas, Jr. Fund and members of the Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy.
