

Public Comments and Responses on the Administrative Record for Ladder Creek Settling Tank Site

The NPS released the Administrative Record for the Ladder Creek Settling Tank Time Critical Removal Action on October 2, 2017 for a 30-day formal comment period which ended October 31, 2017. During this time, the public was welcome to submit comments via the Site website or by mail. Three letters of correspondence were received during this time, two of which related solely to another proposal undergoing review within the National Park Service. The one piece of correspondence that related to this action, and the NPS' response to this comment letter is outlined below.
