Expedited Consistency Response - Concurrence

Dear Ms. Bruno:

The Division of Coastal and Ocean Management (DCOM) has received your consistency determination for the above-referenced activity. You propose to install a sonar acoustic camera within the Bartlett River to count salmonid escapement seasonally between June 1 and November over four seasons. This project is located within Section 3 of Township 39S., Range 58E., Copper River Meridian, near Gustavus, Alaska.

You have determined that your activity has effects to the Alaska Coastal Zone and is consistent to the maximum extent practicable (CMEP) with the enforceable policies of the Alaska Coastal Management Program (ACMP) under Generally Consistent Determination (GCD) #6 – Temporary Fish Research & Management Facilities. This expedited consistency response, developed under 11 AAC 110, applies to the federal consistency determination required for your activity per 15 CFR 930 Subpart C.

DCOM has consulted with State resource agencies, and concurs that your proposed activity is CMEP, since you have proposed in writing to conduct your activity in accordance with the Standard Alternative Measures in GCD #6.

This consistency response is only for your activity as you described it in your consistency determination. If you propose any changes to your activity, federal regulations require that you contact this office to determine if further review and approval is necessary.

By copy of this letter, I am informing State resource agencies the coastal district of DCOM's

concurrence with your determination. State agencies may now issue permits according to their statutory and regulatory procedures.
