Dear Friends of Yosemite National Park:

The National Park Service at Yosemite National Park announces the availability of the *Finding of No Significant Impact* for the *Badger Pass Ski Lodge Rehabilitation*. This document records the decision of the National Park Service to adopt a plan for the rehabilitation of Badger Pass Ski Lodge as described under the Selected Action (Alternative 3 – Rehabilitation and Improvements) in the *Badger Pass Ski Lodge Rehabilitation Environmental Assessment*.

The *Finding of No Significant Impact, Errata Sheets*, and the report summarizing public comment received during public review of the environmental assessment are available at http://parkplanning.nps.gov/BadgerPass.

The National Park Service has determined that implementation of the *Badger Pass Ski Lodge Rehabilitation* will not have a significant effect on the quality of the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement will not be prepared.
