## PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) has been issued by the National Park Service (NPS) and the United States Coast Guard (USCG) for the Environmental Assessment (EA) of the construction of a USCG Rescue 21 communication site at Deception Hills, located in Alaska's Glacier Bay National Park and Preserve. The USCG and the NPS have determined that the proposed action (permit issuance, construction, operation, and maintenance) would not significantly affect the human environment.

The National Park Service (NPS) has decided to issue a permit for Deception Hills before any action associated with this project is implemented.
