Dear Friends of Yosemite National Park:

The National Park Service at Yosemite National Park announces the availability of the Finding of No Significant Impact for the Ahwahnee Comprehensive Rehabilitation Plan. This document records the decision of the National Park Service to adopt a long-term comprehensive plan for the rehabilitation of The Ahwahnee National Historic Landmark. The Selected Action was described as Alternative 3 in the Ahwahnee Comprehensive Rehabilitation Plan Environmental Assessment.

The Finding of No Significant Impact, Errata Sheets, Public Comment and Response Report, and other documentation completing the decision-making process are available at http://parkplanning.nps.gov/AhwahneeRehab.

The National Park Service has determined that implementation of the Ahwahnee Comprehensive Rehabilitation Plan will not have a significant effect on the quality of the human environment. Therefore, an environmental impact statement will not be prepared.

Implementation of the plan will occur over the long-term as funding becomes available. Initial components of the plan will include improving the East Wing fire egress, reconfiguring The Ahwahnee bar, and accessibility improvements.

We thank you for your interest and comments regarding the project. Public participation is a key element in the environmental review process at Yosemite National Park. Your participation helps to ensure that the National Park Service fully understands and considers your values and concerns.
