Dear Ms. White:

At Valley Forge National Historical Park the National Park Service proposes to issue a Request for Proposals to lease the house and immediately associated grounds of the Philander Chase Knox estate. The tenant will use the area for private events between April and the end of October, erecting a tent on the lawn east of the house.

The purpose of the project is to provide managed public access to the house and also to provide revenue for its ongoing maintenance and preservation. Proposed exterior work includes construction of a gravel valet-parking lot and access lane within the former walled garden. The enclosed description provides more detailed information. During our General Management planning/EIS process, which incorporated consultation with the Stockbridge-Munsee Community, we determined that the building and site could be made available for alternate uses.

The project lies in an upland area of the park approximately 500' from any water course. At this time, based on the results of shovel test pits, the park archeologist does not expect that Native American archeological resources will be discovered.

This letter serves as notification that we have begun the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process and propose to complete a draft combined environmental assessment (EA) and assessment of affect (EOA) for public and agency review this summer. We are initiating consultation with you in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
