



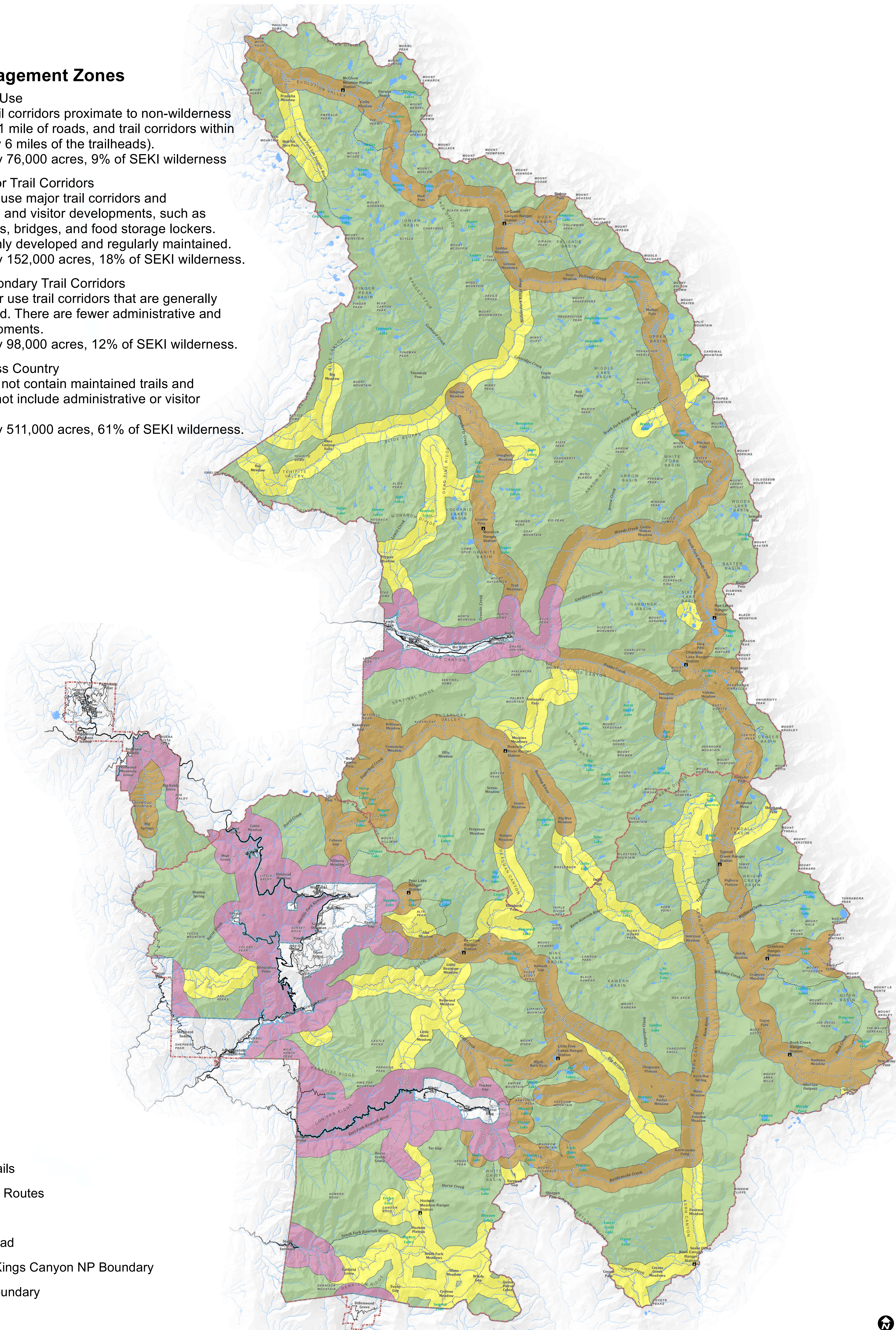










Wilderness Management Zones - Current Conditions

Wilderness Management Zones

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Zone A - Day Use
 Areas and trail corridors proximate to non-wilderness areas (within 1 mile of roads, and trail corridors within approximately 6 miles of the trailheads).
 Approximately 76,000 acres, 9% of SEKI wilderness
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Zone B - Major Trail Corridors
 Includes high use major trail corridors and administrative and visitor developments, such as ranger stations, bridges, and food storage lockers. Trails are highly developed and regularly maintained.
 Approximately 152,000 acres, 18% of SEKI wilderness.
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Zone C - Secondary Trail Corridors
 Includes lower use trail corridors that are generally less developed. There are fewer administrative and visitor developments.
 Approximately 98,000 acres, 12% of SEKI wilderness.
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Zone D - Cross Country
 Areas that do not contain maintained trails and generally do not include administrative or visitor facilities.
 Approximately 511,000 acres, 61% of SEKI wilderness.
