Dear Friend of Bryce Canyon National Park:

The National Park Service is preparing an environmental assessment (EA) for a Multimodal Transportation Plan. This project will enable the park to plan for current and future transportation solutions in an integrated context.

As you may know, the park has been preparing transportation plan alternatives for inclusion in an EA. We would like to get your input on the draft alternatives before continuing the EA process.

The transportation plan will explore a range of potential solutions, from shaping visitor demand in new ways to changes in park operation. The desired outcomes of the transportation plan and draft alternatives include:

- Reducing traffic congestion and parking shortages
- Increasing safety
- Eliminating or minimizing resource conflicts
- Improving the visitor experience
- Improving connectivity for all modes of transportation, including public transportation, private vehicles, tour buses, pedestrians and bicycles
- Improving park operational efficiency

The public is invited to attend an open house to identify issues and provide information to the Park that should be considered in the development of the transportation plan. The open house will be held on **Tuesday, April 16**, 2013 from 5 to 7 p.m. at Bryce Canyon National Park Visitor Center Conference Room D, on the top floor of the building (Highway 63, Bryce Canyon, UT 84764).

An open comment period will begin on April 16th, 2013.
