### **ICE AGE NATIONAL SCENIC TRAIL ROCK COUNTY, WI**

We would like to hear your thoughts about completing the Ice Age National Scenic Trail in Rock County. The purpose of this planning process is to identify the best corridor in which to develop the trail.

The information you received describes four Alternatives: a ‘No Action’ Alternative (#1), Johnstown Moraine/ Rock River East-Alternative #2, Johnstown Moraine/ Rock River West-Alternative #3, and Orfordville Moraine-Alternative #4. Which alternative is your favorite? Which is your least favorite? Why?

Approximately 20 miles of the Ice Age National Scenic Trail already exist in Rock County, including segments at Storrs Lake Wildlife area, Milton and Janesville. Have you hiked the completed segments in Rock County or other areas of the state? Do you have any comments regarding the quality or stewardship of these existing trail segments?
