

# NEPA & Section 106 Process



**DEFINE PURPOSE & NEED** – FOR THE PROPOSED ACTION, NATIONAL PARK SERVICE AND U.S. SECRET SERVICE DEFINE THE PROJECT AREA, AND DEFINE THE FRAMEWORK WITHIN WHICH REASONABLE ALTERNATIVES CAN BE DEVELOPED

**DATA COLLECTION** - BEGIN RESOURCE INVENTORY AND ANALYSIS, DETERMINE RESOURCE TOPICS AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSED ACTION, AND INITIATE DATA COLLECTION/ RESEARCH NEEDED TO CARRY IMPACT ANALYSIS FORWARD

**INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL SCOPING** - HOLD PUBLIC SCOPING MEETINGS TO INTRODUCE PROJECT AND IDENTIFY ISSUES

**NATIONAL CAPITAL PLANNING COMMISSION (NCPC)** HELD A DESIGN COMPETITION FOR THE PROJECT AREA, THE RESULTS OF WHICH INFORMED THE DEVELOPMENT OF ALTERNATIVES FOR THE PROJECT.

**DESCRIBE AFFECTED ENVIRONMENT, DEVELOP ALTERNATIVES, AND PREPARE IMPACT ANALYSIS OF ALTERNATIVES**

**PREPARE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT**

**RELEASE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (EA) FOR 30-DAY PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT**

**NATIONAL PARK SERVICE AND U.S. SECRET SERVICE TO REVIEW AND ADDRESS PUBLIC COMMENTS RECEIVED ON THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND RESPOND TO COMMENTS**

**PREPARE AND FINALIZE FONSI, IF APPROPRIATE AND DRAFT SECTION 106 AGREEMENT DOCUMENT.**
