Comments Requested for Proposed Snake Creek Improvements and Recreational Enhancement Project

Great Basin National Park is currently seeking issues and comments for the proposed Snake Creek Improvement and Recreational Enhancement project. Your issues and comments will assist us in developing an environmental analysis consistent with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

The proposed action would use Southern Nevada Public Lands Management Act (SNPLMA) funds to: improve public access to areas; address portions of previous resource impacts; and add new trail features and facilities that will enhance the visitor experience while addressing the operational and maintenance needs of the park.
