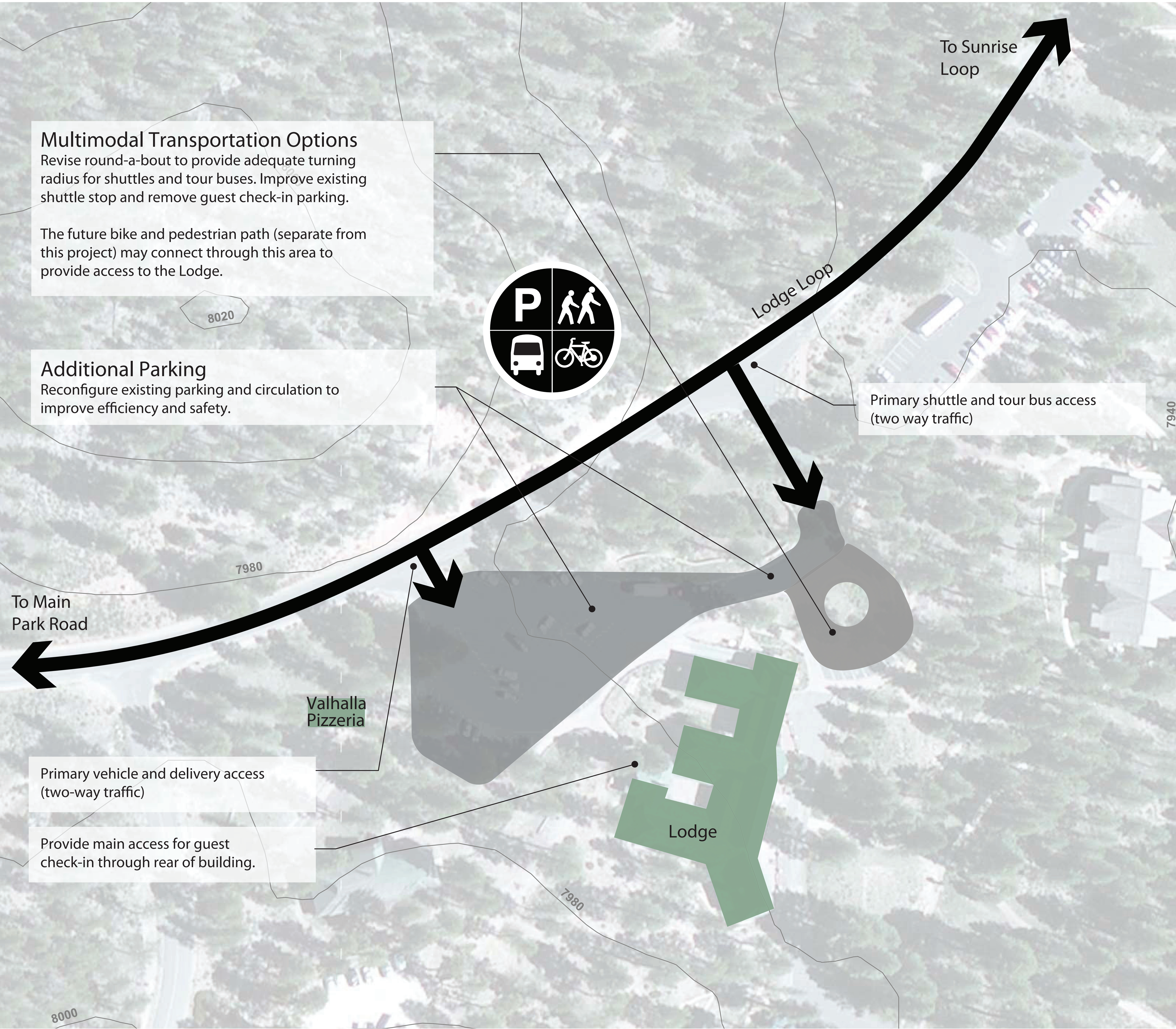


Preferred Alternative Detail Lodge Loop

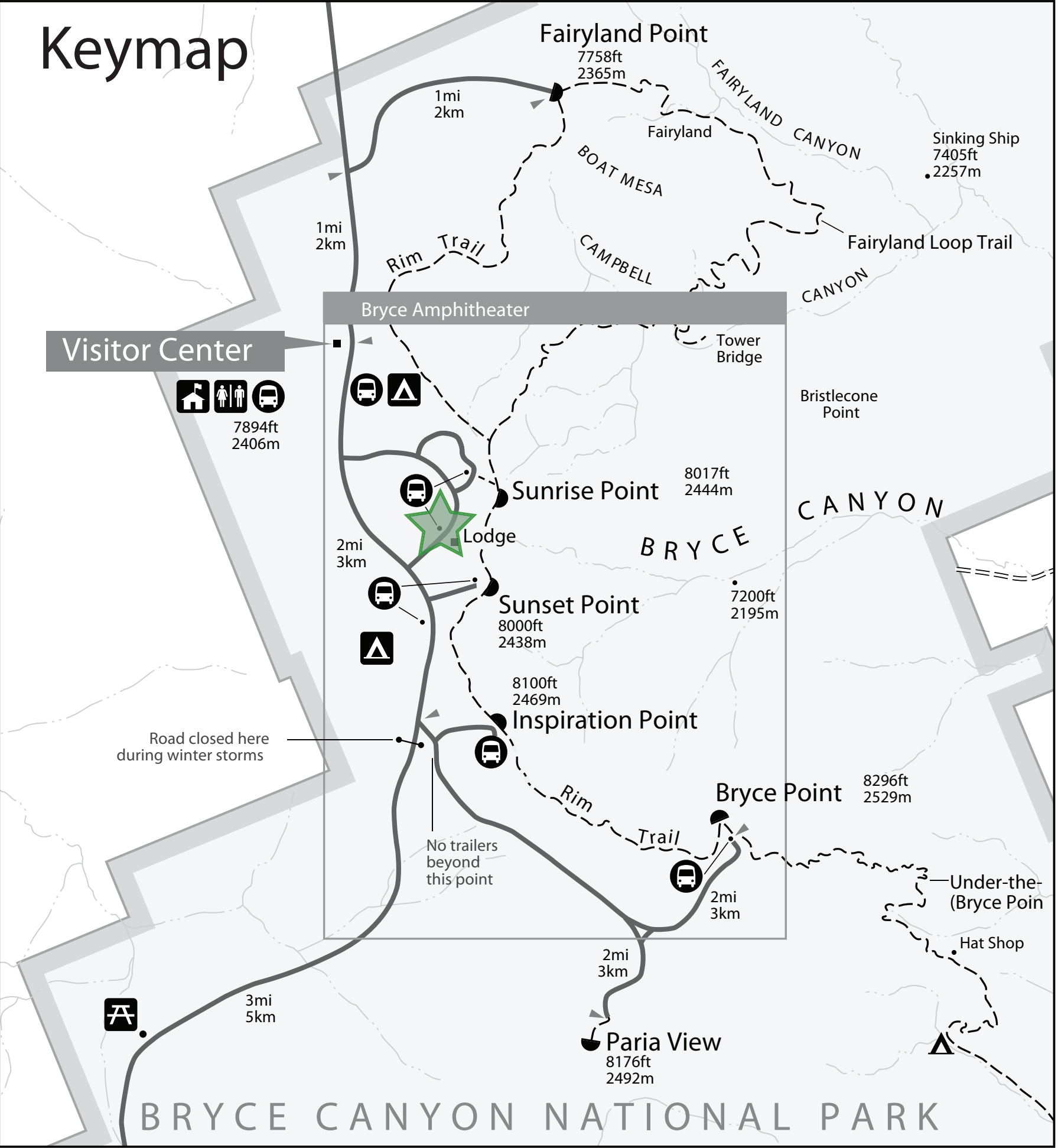

Purpose

- * Reduces confusion for Lodge guests and visitors by improving parking configuration and circulation for different vehicle types.
- * Reduce conflicts between pedestrians, cars, buses and shuttles by separating regular access for car and delivery vehicles from access for shuttles and buses.
- * Provide flexible design options that can be phased in over time as needed.

Desired Time Frame

- * Short term: Reconfigure parking and improve round-a-bout.
- * Long term: Monitor success of improvements and adjust as needed.

Design Considerations

- * Explore ways to consolidate development footprint.
- * Incorporate stormwater management techniques such as bioswales, etc.
- * Soften visual impacts with appropriate buffers and design elements.
