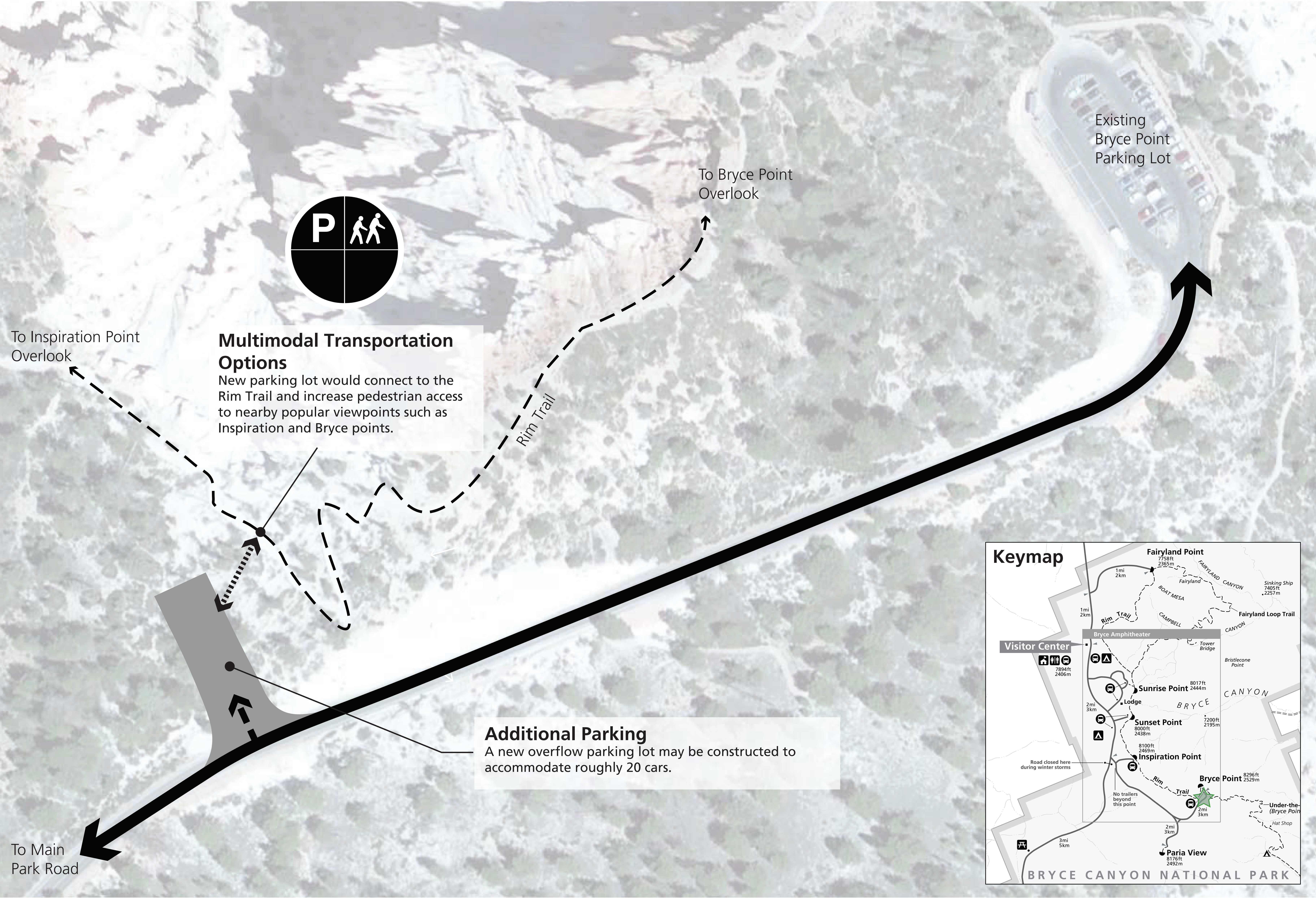


Preferred Alternative Detail Bryce Point Parking Expansion

Purpose

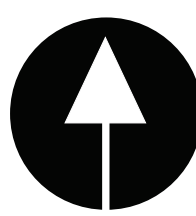
- * Provide additional overflow parking at one of the park's most popular hiking destinations, especially when shuttle is not running.

Desired Time Frame

- * Short term: Monitor conditions.
- * Long term: Construct overflow parking lot if needed.

Design Considerations

- * Explore ways to consolidate development footprint.
- * Incorporate stormwater management techniques such as bioswales, etc.
- * Soften visual impacts with appropriate buffers and design elements.
- * Provide for seasonal closure of parking lot as appropriate.
