

**Listed below are corrections to the Cape Lookout Draft ORV Management Plan / DEIS, released on May 14, 2014, and open for public comment through July 21, 2014.**

- 1) P. 113, 127, 141, 155 (map)
  - a. Sound-side beach to north should not be colored purple as a closure. Sound-side beaches are already closed to ORV use. Portsmouth Village continues to be a year-round closure and maintains shading for clarification.
- 2) P. 137 (map)
  - a. Page number should be 137, "not 137 157"
- 3) P. 155 (map)
  - a. There should be purple shading representing a seasonal summer beach closure from the Portsmouth Road (designated vehicle route represented as a dotted line) north to the demarcation line for 1.6 miles.
- 4) P. 151 (map)
  - a. Purple shading should extend from Ramp 41a to Ramp 42a, NOT Ramp 41b
  - b. Page number should be 151, not "151 171"
- 5) P. 159 (map)
  - a. Map should show Middle Core Banks (currently separated from North Core Banks starting at mile marker 19) as a seasonal summer closure of 3.6 miles.
- 6) P. 165 (map)
  - a. Purple shading should extend from Ramp 41a to Ramp 42b, NOT Ramp 41b
  - b. Page number should be 165, not "165 185"
- 7) P. 81 (alternatives chart)
  - a. Under Alternatives B, C, and D, the following statement should be added: "Regular maintenance of the back route would be performed as needed."
- 8) P. 244, Table 35, Cabin Lodging in October and December 2012 was reported as 0. This is an error, and NPS is currently determining the correct number.
