Dear Chairman May:

At its regularly scheduled, properly noticed meeting on September 9, 2014, with a quorum present, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6B voted 4-3-2 to send this letter supporting selection of Marion Park as the site for the Francis Marion Memorial, provided that (1) the memorial does not interfere with the children's playground and, therefore, is not placed on the western plot of the park; (2) funding for the long-term maintenance of the memorial is obtained in advance of its completion; (3) a clearly defined role for the community in the process is created from this point forward; and (4) the National Park Service takes a holistic approach to park spaces and their maintenance on Capitol Hill.
