## Public Meeting Reschedule for October 15, 2015

Public Comment Period Opens for Environmental Assessment on Issuance of Special Use Permit to Local Government for Beach Nourishment Project

Manteo, NC – The National Park Service (NPS) has announced that the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) has released for public review an environmental assessment (EA) for the purpose of beach nourishment activities in the Buxton area of Cape Hatteras National Seashore.

Dare County has requested a Clean Water Act Section 404 permit from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) for the associated dredge and fill activities needed to accomplish the proposed beach nourishment activities.

Dare County has requested a special use permit from the NPS for fill activities on Cape Hatteras National Seashore.

The USACE and NPS are working as cooperating agencies to review the proposed project under the National Environmental Policy Act and will use the EA to assist the agencies in determining whether, where and under what conditions the NPS and USACE would issue permits to Dare County.
