Enclosed for your information and review is an environmental assessment (EA) on a proposal from the Federal Aviation Administration to install two automated Weather Camera System (WCAM) at Merrill Pass and continue the operation of the Remote Communications Outlet and WCAM at Lake Clark Pass in Lake Clark National Park and Preserve. The NPS would issue a right-of-way to the FAA for the installation and operation of the WCAMs. The FAA proposes to install the WCAM sites during the summer of 2007.

The EA was completed in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, and the regulations of the Council on Environmental Quality (40 CFR 1508.9).

The comment period for the EA will extend 30 days, beginning April 5 and ending May 5, 2006. Please send written comments to:
