



Backcountry Management Zones

Wild
Recommended for highly experienced canyon hikers only. Indistinct or no routes, requiring advanced route finding ability. No facilities.
Very low density use; potential for no contact with others.

Primitive
Recommended for highly experienced canyon hikers only. Minimal facilities, unmaintained trails and routes.
Low density use; infrequent contact with others

Proposed Road Natural Zone at SB Point

Threshold
Recommended for hikers with Grand Canyon experience. Most areas with designated campsites and toilets. Infrequently maintained trails.
Medium density use; potential for frequent contact with other parties

Proposed River Zone at Granite Rapids

Corridor
Recommended for hikers with no Grand Canyon backcountry experience. Ranger Stations, permanent structures, toilets, water, bridges, maintained trails, emergency phones.
Largest and most popular campsites
