


Adaptive Management

What is it?

Adaptive management is a decision process that promotes flexible decision making that can be adjusted in the face of uncertainties as outcomes from management actions and other events become better understood. Adaptive management does not represent an end in itself, rather a means to more effective decisions and enhanced benefits for park resources and visitor experiences (DOI 2008).






- River-assisted backcountry travel (RABT)




