




Dosewallips Alternative A - Current Management




1. Road access would be provided.




Dosewallips Alternative B - Resource Protection Emphasis

2. The campground and ranger station would be reduced or eliminated.





Dosewallips Alternative C - Visitor Opportunities Emphasis




1. Road access would be improved.
