RE: Enchanted Valley Chalet MOA Annual Report

Dear Ms. Harris,

On August 7, 2014, the park finalized the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for the emergency action to move the Enchanted Valley Chalet away from the river to prevent environmental harm to the river should the chalet collapse into the river as the bank eroded. The State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation and Olympic National Park were signatories on the MOA. The Quinault Indian Nation signed as a concurring party.

The MOA includes ten stipulations. Stipulation VIII requires submission of an annual report to all parties to the agreement. Enclosed is the first annual report fulfilling the park's obligation under this stipulation. A copy of the signed MOA is also enclosed for your convenience.
