The National Park Service, in cooperation with the Friends of the World War II Memorial, hereby requests Concept Design review for the FDR Prayer Plaque at the Commission's June 15, 2017 meeting.

Public Law 113-123 authorized placement of a suitable plaque at the site of the World War II Memorial with the words that President Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the United States on June 6, 1944, the morning of D-Day. The Commission previously reviewed potential locations for the plaque within the site of the World War II Memorial, confirmed its appropriate location within the "Circle of Remembrance" and provided guidance for the design of the plaque and related improvements.
