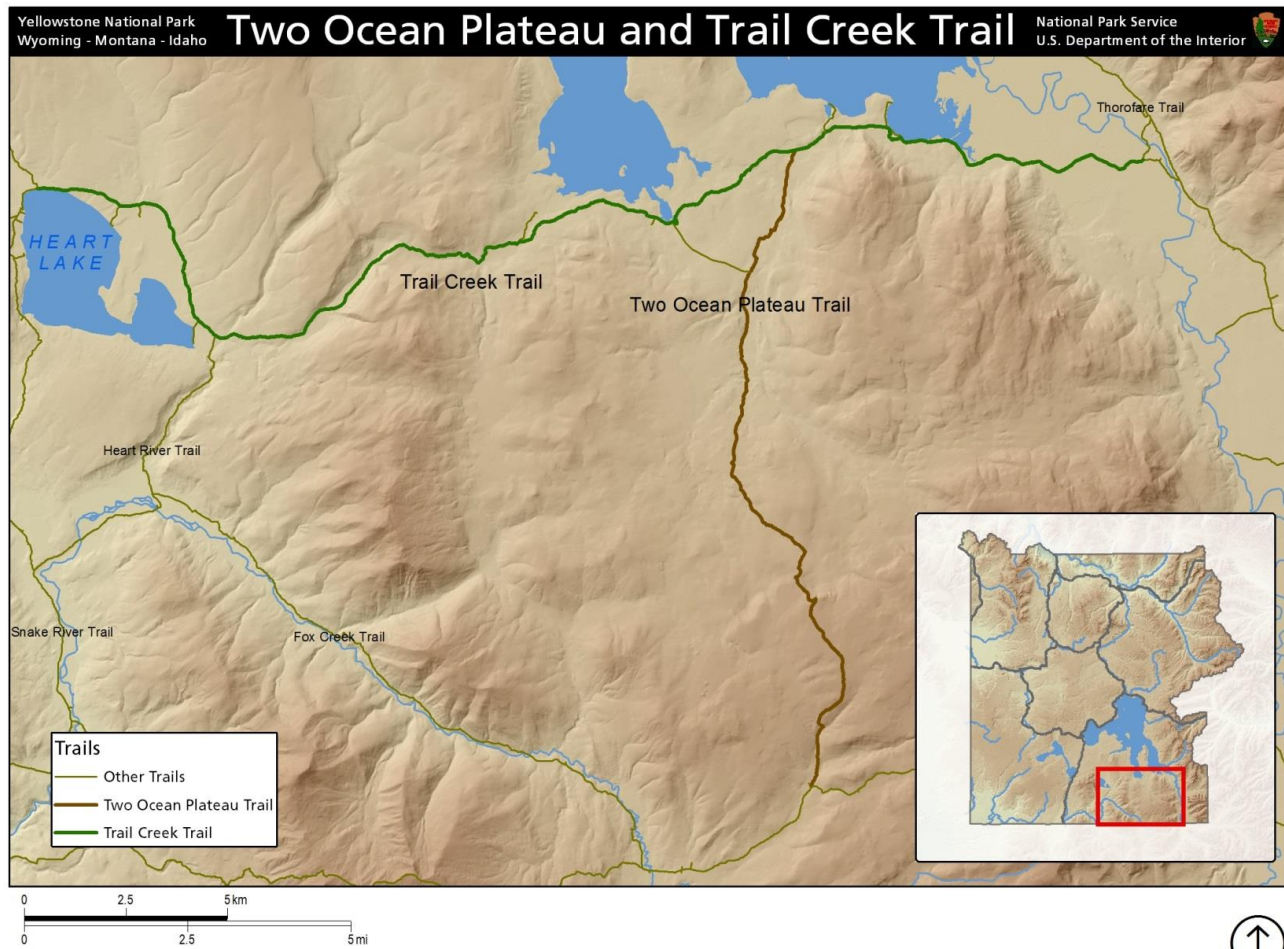

TWO OCEAN PLATEAU AND TRAIL CREEK PROJECT

National Park Service (NPS) is accepting comments regarding a proposed project on hiking trails in the southern part of the park. The project would involve portions of the Two Ocean Plateau and Trail Creek hiking trails that were damaged or destroyed by spring water run-off. This project would repair that damage and alleviate a problematic stream crossing during the summer of 2018. Yellowstone has applied to Wyoming State Parks, Historic Sites, & Trails Recreational Trails Program for a grant to support this project. Appropriate compliance would be completed before project begins to fulfill National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA).



POSSIBLE ACTIONS

Possible actions for this project may include:

- Improve approximately 10 miles of trail
- Ensure the protection of sensitive terrain through extensive erosion control work
- Reroute approximately 400 yards of trail
- Involve constructing a small bridge for stock use
