Enclosed for your information and review is an environmental assessment (EA) in which the the National Park Service is considering a land exchange in Lake Clark National Park and Preserve. The Southcentral Foundation owns a 79.98 acre tract located on the southwestern shore of Lake Clark in the preserve at Sucker Bay and wishes to exchange it for a 4.95-acre parcel near Silver Salmon Creek between Tuxedni and Chinitna Bays in the park.

The EA was completed in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, and the regulations of the Council on Environmental Quality (40 CFR 1508.9).
