 this project on their behalf.
- Please provide copies of all appropriate insurance.

Upon NPS' receipt and approval of the above materials, we will be able to move forward and process Complete Wireless Consulting, Inc.'s application. Once a complete application is received, the next steps in the right-of-way permitting process may include environmental compliance and appraisal and agreement on permit terms. As part of the permitting process, Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks may implement cost recovery for processing the application. Cost recovery includes administrative and environmental compliance costs, including cost of an appraisal.


