Request for Temporary Access to Collect Information Necessary to Prepare a Plan of Operations for the Knight Phase IV 3-D Seismic Survey

Dear Mr. Sadler:

In reply to the May 16, 2006, letter from Tanya Matherne, Dixie Environmental Services Co. (DESCO), on behalf of Seismic Assistants, Ltd. (SAL), I am hereby granting SAL temporary access to the Turkey Creek Unit of Big Thicket National Preserve for a period not to exceed 60 days, beginning on May 22, 2006. The purpose of the permit is solely for the mapping and sampling of vegetation in accordance with Seismic Assistants, Ltd's Knight Phase IV 3D: Big Thicket National Preserve Turkey Creek Unit Vegetation Mapping and Sampling Plan submitted to the National Park Service by DESCO in April 2006. This temporary access is granted pursuant to 36 CFR 9.38(a)(1). Access is limited to areas for which SAL has demonstrated the requisite mineral rights to the NPS. You may request a subsequent temporary access permit to proceed to conduct additional resource surveys and survey source and receiver line locations necessary to prepare a plan of operations and environmental assessment.

Approval to conduct the vegetation mapping and sampling is limited by the following conditions:

- Access by motorized vehicles will be limited to existing roads.
- No cutting of vegetation will be permitted.
- Harassing, injuring, or destroying wildlife is prohibited (including all snakes). It is
  illegal to damage or destroy nests or dens of wildlife, and appropriate measures will
  be employed to avoid these areas.
- All work activities will be conducted during daylight hours.
- Possession of firearms is prohibited.
- SAL will be responsible for equipment/supplies stored within Preserve boundaries.
- All cans, bottles, paper, and other trash will be removed from the Preserve daily.

• There will be no collection of natural or cultural materials other than those provided for in the vegetation mapping and sampling plan referenced above.
