RESPONSE TO COMMENTS SUPERINTENDENT'S COMPENDIUM 2021 DENALI NATIONAL PARK AND PRESERVE

The compendium is a written compilation of designations, closures, permit requirements, and other restrictions adopted under the Superintendent's discretionary authority. A public comment period was held January 15 – February 15, 2021 regarding changes proposed for incorporation into the 2021 Denali National Park and Preserve Superintendent's Compendium. Two submissions were received, both regarding changes related to regulation of e-bikes and neither containing substantive comments.

The comments received by the NPS regarding e-bikes stressed the need for the NPS to manage that use to protect public safety and park resources. In addition to the changes to the 2021 compendium addressing e-bike use, the NPS manages e-bike use through existing regulations in section 13.50 of the Superintendent's Compendium as well as the general provisions of 36 CFR related to traffic safety and hazardous conduct. The NPS has the authority to manage e-bike use under these existing regulations to project public safety and park resources.
