Devils Postpile National Monument to Open Civic Engagement for Proposed Wastewater Project

Devils Postpile National Monument will open civic engagement on Wednesday, March 17, 2021 for a proposed project that will improve the park's wastewater system. This project will test percolation rates for and install a new leach field, septic tanks, and associated piping for the wastewater system which serve the visitor center and administrative areas of the park.

This proposed project will also replace the comfort stations in the park's campground and day-use area with improved restroom facilities that are accessible. Additionally, this project will add vault toilets to expand capacity during the peak summer season, which will better serve visitors coming to experience Devils Postpile National Monument.
