Over the last several years, the National Park Service (NPS), U.S. Navy and the USS Constitution Museum have been working to develop a master development strategy that aims to transform the National Park area of the Charlestown Navy Yard. We imagine a place that welcomes people from around the corner and around the world. Several workshops have been held to discuss creating a world-class visitor experience, upholding a stewardship ethic that allows for the landscape to evolve and be preserved, and reimagining the Navy Yard as portal to the Harbor, the Freedom Trail, and to our community's heritage and public space. We now invite your input on the proposed project ideas during this planning phase.

The NPS will be accepting comments on the preliminary project concepts from June 2 through July 1, 2021.
