

## Challenges

- Ad Hoc Development
- Lack Strategic Vision
- Employees Spread Out Across Multiple Locations
- Historic Buildings and Landscapes in Poor Condition
- Military Security Within a National Park
- \$175M+ Deferred Maintenance






#### **Studies and Plans**








## **Public Law 116-152**

Landmark conservation legislation will use revenues from energy development to provide up to \$1.9 billion a year for five years to provide needed maintenance for critical facilities and infrastructure in our national parks, forests, wildlife refuges, recreation areas, and American Indian schools.








