Parking Fee Fact Sheet

What:

This proposed project will:

Implement a Parking Fee Program at Pearl Harbor National Memorial

When:

This project is proposed to be implemented by early 2023.

Who:

This project will be staffed entirely by National Park Service employees. There are no contracts associated with fee collection.

Where:

1. Parking fees will be required at visitor lots A,C,D (see attached) Pearl Harbor National Memorial.


Parking Fee Program:

• Fees Collected at all public parking lots. Daily rate \$7

Why:

Additionally, the generated funds will go directly to deferred maintenance in the park, such as upkeep and maintenance on the USS *Arizona* memorial as well as park sites on Ford Island which includes the USS *Utah*, USS Oklahoma memorials, and the historic Chief Petty Officer (CPO) Bungalows. Generated revenue will also support the park's deferred maintenance, upkeep, and operations of the parking lots, and enhance visitor services such as security, exhibits, and leveraging technology to better reach a more modern audience.

This new fee would be collected under the authority of Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act which establishes fee collection on federal lands, and National Parks collecting fees can retain 80% of those revenues in order to support projects that improve the visitor experience the remainder is used for projects throughout the National Park Service.
