The property is wooded, except for the clearing immediately surrounding the house. The house and property are inside the Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania County Battlefields Memorial National Military Park, the boundary of which was extended to include this and other properties in the 1980's. Private property adjoins the Markham House to the northwest, while National Park Service property adjoins it to the south and west.
