#### Site Description:

August 2021: The Markham House fronts on Old Plank Road (County Route #610) near the southern end of the Chancellorsville Battlefield. The property is wooded, except for the clearing immediately surrounding the house. The house and property are inside the Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania County Battlefields Memorial National Military Park, the boundary of which was extended to include this and other properties in the 1980's. Private property adjoins the Markham House to the northwest, while National Park Service property adjoins it to the south and west.

#### Surveyor Assessment:

August 2021: The Markham House has no connection to important events at any level, is not connected to significant individuals, is not believed to have any special characteristics of type, period, or method of construction, and is not linked to pre-historical or historical information. The Markham House is recommended not individually eligible for the National Register of Historic Places and does not contribute to the Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania County Battlefields National Military Park Historic District.
