



CHICKAMAUGA AND CHATTANOOGA NATIONAL MILITARY PARK RESOURCES

Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park was established in 1890 and consists of 9,036 acres. It is this country's oldest and largest National Military Park.

Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park has 738 items on the NPS List of Classified Structures, to include:

- 705 Commemorative Features
- 261 Monuments
- 362 Stone Markers
- 82 Bronze Tablet Markers
- 800 Interpretive Tablets

Our Museum Collection contains over 95,000 items, which include:

- 355 Fuller Gun Collection
- 256 Artillery Pieces
- "The Battle of Lookout Mountain" (a 13' X 30' painting by James Walker)

Other items include:

- 21 Cultural Landscapes
- 119 documented Archeological Site
- One threatened and endangered species (the Large Flowered Skullcap)
