

Seeking Input on Wilderness Study for Channel Islands National Park

Dear Friends,

For the past several years the National Park Service (NPS) has been working on a new General Management Plan / Environmental Impact Statement for Channel Islands National Park, which is the guiding document for park management. We are now expanding this planning effort to include a wilderness study to determine if any NPS-owned lands within the park should be recommended for inclusion in the National Wilderness Preservation System. The park's enabling legislation requires this wilderness study; wilderness designation in the park would require an act of Congress.

We will be holding public open houses in Ventura and Santa Barbara to hear your comments regarding wilderness in Channel Islands National Park.

Public open houses will be held on June 17, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at the Channel Islands National Park Visitor Center auditorium, 1901 Spinnaker Dr., Ventura, and on June 18, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at the Faulkner Gallery, Santa Barbara Public Library, 40 E. Anapamu St., Santa Barbara. We will use this information in developing alternative wilderness proposals as part of the General Management Plan / Wilderness Study / Environmental Impact Statement.
