


Location of Two Proposed, One-Story Livestock Sheds Green Springs National Historic Landmark District




Site-Plan, APE (Blue): 2 proposed, 1-story livestock sheds: Green Springs NHLD

(black solar-panels mounted flat on roof that slopes down and away, south, from viewer in this perspective)




composition/color: wood posts and side-walls colored brown; gravel floor; same design/ composition as west shed

hole for ea. of 8 footers: 2' x 2' x 4' deep




Site, Elevation, Proposed West Shed, Looking South in Photo and in Inset (approx. center of site of shed at "X")

Proposed Sheds, Setting, Looking South from Virginia Rt. 22

Proposed Sheds: Route of Proposed Buried, Power Conduit Connecting those to House, Looking West toward it

underground route (yellow line) of westernmost segment of proposed, buried conduit for power generated by proposed sheds' rooftop solar-collectors, carrying power from those to house; conduitinstallation along its entire length would require excavation 4 inches wide, 2 feet deep, 250 feet long total
