GENERAL ORDER NO. 467.

SUBJECT: Jurisdiction of a part of U. S. Reservation No. 412 assumed by the Commissioners of the District of Columbia.

1. In accordance with the provisions of the Act of Congress, approved February 23, 1931 (Public No. 721 - 71st Congress, 46 Stat., 1413), the Commissioners of the District of Columbia were authorized to assume jurisdiction, for the purpose of constructing a reservoir, of parts of Lots 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109 and 110 in Square 5778; part of Lot 70 in Square 5755, and part of Parcel 220/9. The area described above contains 21,787.39 square feet, and was formerly known as a part of Fort Stanton Park, U. S. Reservation No. 412.


