Project: Removal of Invasive Silk Trees at Alley Mill

Project Description: Project Objective: The OZAR Fire Management Staff will remove invasive-exotic Silk Trees (Albizia julibrissin), also known as Mimosa, along the Alley Mill Spring Branch. Mimosa trees are established along the spring branch and are continuing to spread. Many of the trees overhang the spring branch, allowing for seeds/seed pods to be deposited into the spring branch and thus potentially aiding in population establishment downstream. Additionally, the numerous numbers of Mimosa trees has inhibited the historical `open' viewshed of the Alley Mill from the bridge. Treatment Method: Cut stump. All Mimosa trees are to be cut horizontal to the ground and at or near ground level. Immediately apply a 50% solution of AquaNeat (EPA No. 228-365) and water to the cut stump making sure to cover the entire outer 20% of the stump. Chemical should be applied with a hand-held spray bottle in order to avoid drift and/or application to non-target vegetation. Seed pods that have fallen off the tree due to cutting (i.e. hitting the ground and breaking loose from the tree) need to be removed in order to discourage potential spread in "unaffected areas". Rainfall Advisory: Chemical should not be used if rain is projected within 6 hours of application. Disposal: Mimosa trees will need to be removed off site (whole or chipped) to a burn pile with the intent of burning the pile this winter (this will help ensure no seed germination and/or spread of the species to other areas within the park). PPE: Individuals applying herbicide need to follow label instructions for PPE requirements. Clean sprayers and parts immediately after using this product by thoroughly flushing with water and dispose of rinsate according to labeled use or disposal instructions.
