OFF TRAIL, ON TRAIL, BACKCOUNTRY CAMPGROUND	DEVELOPED AREA or ROADSIDE
1. CLOSE AREA.	1. INVESTIGATE: A. CLOSE as necessary to insure safety. B. Enforcement actions may be indicated.
2. NOTIFY DISPATCH and DOCUMENT	2. CONTROL PEOPLE
3. INVESTIGATE, PHOTOGRAPH, and ID bear.	3. Attempt to REMOVE bear: A. Bear REMOVED: 1. OPEN area. 2. NOTIFY DISPATCH & DOCUMENT B. Bear NOT REMOVED: 1. MAINTAIN closure, PATROL & monitor for additional reports. 2. OPEN after patrols indicate target bear is no longer in the area. 3. NOTIFY DISPATCH & DOCUMENT 4. MAINTAIN alert status for return of target bear.
4. Bear observed: A. REMOVE B. BIMS filed, sent to Resources Management C. OPEN area D. NOTIFY DISPATCH & DOCUMENT	4/2010
5. Bear not observed: A. Prepare to REMOVE target bear. B. PATROL and closely monitor additional reports for return of target bear to same or other area. C. KEEP area closed until information indicates bear has moved away. D. OPEN area after patrols indicate target bear is not in the area. E. BIMS report to Resources Management F. NOTIFY DISPATCH & DOCUMENT G. MAINTAIN alert status for return of target bear.
