



# The Future of Orrs Ferry

The National Park Service (NPS) developed a site management plan for the Orrs Ferry unit at the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area (CRNRA). This plan aims to enhance visitor experiences, protect natural and cultural resources, and guide development over the next 20 years.

## Proposed Changes

The plan aims to enhance visitor experiences, improve resource protection, and use existing structures efficiently. The plan emphasizes demolishing existing infrastructure on both sides of the river, with scaled development on the west side, including expanded parking facilities, picnic areas, and upgraded amenities. Changes on the east side of the area abutting Highway 20 would be limited.
